Dear Lead Deputy Attorney General Minton,

Please find attached the form related to your request regarding concealed weapons license reciprocity between Michigan and Idaho. An Idaho resident who is licensed by that state to carry a concealed pistol may also carry that concealed pistol in Michigan. Mich Comp Laws 28.432a(h). However, that individual must carry in conformance with any restrictions appearing on the Idaho license and that individual is subject to Michigan's concealed pistol laws including, but not limited to, restrictions on where a concealed pistol may be carried.

In addition, please be advised that responsibility for handling firearms issues has been transferred to the Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division of the Michigan Department of Attorney General. Please update your contact information with the following:
