

IDAHO CIVIL ASSET FORFEITURE REPORTING FORM

PURPOSE: A local law enforcement agency that has seized or forfeited property pursuant to IDAHO CODE § 37-2744 is required to make an annual forfeiture report on or before March 31st to the local prosecuting attorney with jurisdiction over the forfeiture on the form approved and made available by Idaho State Police. IDAHO CODE § 37-2744(j); IDAPA 11, Title 06, Chapter 01.

INSTRUCTIONS: Pursuant to IDAHO CODE § 37-2744(j), all local law enforcement agencies must submit this IDAHO CIVIL ASSET FORFEITURE REPORTING FORM **to the prosecuting attorney of its jurisdiction on or before March 31st.**
