

IDAHO CIVIL ASSET FORFEITURE REPORTING FORM

PURPOSE: A local law enforcement agency that has seized or forfeited property pursuant to Idaho Code § 37-2744(j) is required to retain certain pertinent information from the previous calendar year and submit it to the county prosecutor for its jurisdiction.

INSTRUCTIONS: For each property seizure or forfeiture it undertakes, the law enforcement agency must submit this completed form to its county prosecutor on or before March 31st of each year. This form is available at: <https://isp.idaho.gov/districts/district-forms/>.
