BREAKOUT SESSIONS

CJIS APB & Topic Paper – Sandy Kelleher

Bureau of Criminal Identification Operations Officer, Sandy Kelleher, will discuss how the CJIS Advisory Policy Board handles changes to NCIC. We will discuss how topic papers are submitted and share stories about how Idaho has contributed to changes to the system that benefit the law enforcement community.

Nlets Training – Teri Harsin

Teri Harsin will discuss what Nlets is, how it differs from NCIC, and show the capabilities that can get you information from across the globe.

Sex Assault Initiative (SAKI) – Daren Boyd & Mark Denhardt

The Sex Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI) team talks about what they do for the State, and how they work with local agencies to ensure justice for victims of assault.

Stress Management & Burnout – Eren Barker

Law enforcement professionals operate under intense and sustained pressure including rapid decision-making, emotional labor, public scrutiny, and unpredictable environments. This fast-paced, interactive session gives officers practical, field-ready tools to recognize stress overload, interrupt burnout patterns, and reset their nervous system in real time. Designed specifically for high-stress, high-stakes roles, this session focuses on simple, tactical strategies that can be used on shift, between calls, or after critical incidents to support long-term performance, resilience, and well-being.

Subscription and Notification Service – Amy Vezoso

Subscription and Notification Service is an FBI service and state-level program that provides authorized agencies with continuous, real-time notifications of an individual's subsequent criminal activity after an initial fingerprint-based background check. This notification service is provided based on state-level approval; currently, Idaho is approved for criminal justice supervision. It works by retaining fingerprints in databases (like the FBI's NGI system), allowing automatic comparison with new arrests to alert agencies about new criminal history. Idaho is now offering the Idaho Department of Corrections, Probation and Parole, the opportunity to participate.

UCR / NIBRS Reporting – Julie Houck

Audit & Training Specialist, Julie Houck, discusses how to report data into the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program and the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS).

Recommended Audience: General users, UCR/NIBRS data contributors

Violent Person File (VPF) Entry – Chris Bodovinitz

ILETS Audit & Training Specialist, Chris Bodovinitz, walks through how to enter a subject into the NCIC Violent Person File. Chris will demonstrate how to enter the Carl Public test record into this file to provide attendees with a visual demonstration of this process.
