Regular: IDAHO CODE § 18-3302 Enhanced: IDAHO CODE § 18-3302K Both Neither Florida will recognize Idaho licenses issued to Idaho residents 21 years of age or older. The age requirement does not apply to a person who is a service member as defined in s. 250.01, F.S., or is a veteran of the United States Armed Forces discharged under honorable conditions. Those persons may carry a concealed weapon or concealed firearm if they are 18 years of age or older. Does this state require a reciprocity agreement?
