Course Description

This course provides RNs and APRNs with the knowledge to practice as a sexual assault nurse examiner (SANE). The SANE uses the nursing process and applies established evidence-based standards of forensic nursing practice to ensure that all patients reporting sexual violence and victimization receive competent a nursing, medical-forensic evaluation, taking into consideration developmental, cultural, racial, ethnic, gender identity, sexual, and socioeconomic diversity.

Overall Learning Outcome

RNs who are trained as SANEs will provide comprehensive, compassionate, and competent medicoforensic evaluations to patients who have experienced sexual violence.

Continuing Nursing Education Credits

Participants who attend the course in its entirety, complete daily sign in, and complete the course evaluation will meet the requirements for successful completion.

Participants will receive 40.0 Contact Hours for their successful completion of the SANE Pediatric/Adolescent Course. Certificates will be emailed to participants after the evaluation period closes.
