- Gonorrhea: Rocephin 500 mg IM once
- Trichomoniasis: Flagyl 2 gram by mouth once
  - Do not drink alcohol or products with alcohol (like cough syrup) for at least 3 days if you were given Flagyl, it will make you vomit.

It is recommended that you follow up in 2 weeks with your own private physician/OB/GYN. Please, take this form with you to the appointment so the Provider is aware of the testing and medications that have already been administered.

Consider using a condom for intercourse for up to 3 months. This will prevent any potential partners from acquiring a sexually transmitted infection.

A staff member from The Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Center will contact you with the next 72 hours. Their staff has been specifically trained to help with crisis counseling and referral to private counseling along with support groups and community assistance. Their number is 208-529-4352 and their 24-hour crisis line is 208-235-2412.

**Danger Signals:** If you have any further concerns or your condition worsens in anyway, please see your doctor or go the Emergency Department for further evaluation and treatment:

- You develop any new symptoms such as abdominal pain, nausea, or vomiting.
- You develop a fever greater than 100.5 F or 38 C
- You have pain, discharge or sores around your genital area

Anal Trauma: Increase your dietary fiber and water intake. Warm sitz baths, 10 to 15 min, can relax the anal sphincter and improve blood flow and healing. Avoid soaps and bubble baths. If you have blood clots or the toilet fills with blood return to the ER for evaluation.
