- \_\_\_\_\_ Protective sac with two compartments
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2-3cm erectile body
- \_\_\_\_\_ Bordered by clitoris, inner aspects of l. minora, and posterior Fourchette
- \_\_\_\_\_ Prominence caused by fatty pad over symphysis in the female
- \_\_\_\_\_ Prominent posterior border of the glans penis
- \_\_\_\_\_ Located between Posterior Fourchette and anus
- \_\_\_\_\_ Canal that moves sperm into urethra during ejaculation
- \_\_\_\_\_ Membrane that separates the external genitalia from the vagina
- \_\_\_\_\_ Encircles the proximal urethra, produces ejaculatory fluid
- \_\_\_\_\_ Retractable fold of skin over the glans penis
- \_\_\_\_\_ Body that separates the Posterior Fourchette from the hymen
- \_\_\_\_\_ Rounded folds of skin that form the outer boundary of the external genitalia
- \_\_\_\_\_ Oval gonads that produce hormones and sperm
- \_\_\_\_\_ Erectile tissue that encircles the urethra
- \_\_\_\_\_ Female urethral glands
- \_\_\_\_\_ Conic expansion of corpus spongiosum that forms the head of the penis
- \_\_\_\_\_ Merge posteriorly to form the Posterior Fourchette
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tubular structure stretching from cervix to the hymen
- \_\_\_\_\_ Passes urine from bladder
- \_\_\_\_\_ Female external genitalia

## TANNER STAGING

Stage 1-5

Characteristics

- \_\_\_\_\_ Adult Genitalia
- \_\_\_\_\_ Adult pubic hair in type, but does not extend to thighs
- \_\_\_\_\_ Papilla elevated above the level of the chest wall
- \_\_\_\_\_ Scrotal skin may be reddened and thin, covering enlarging testes
- \_\_\_\_\_ Breast enlarges and areolae and papilla form secondary mounds
- \_\_\_\_\_ Vellus hair at base of penis
- \_\_\_\_\_ Penis lengthens as testes continue to grow
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hair extends onto thighs
- \_\_\_\_\_ Breasts are small mounds, areolae widens and enlarges; may be tender and asymmetrical
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sparse growth of downy hair on labia majora
- \_\_\_\_\_ Breasts no longer have two mounds
- \_\_\_\_\_ Penis and testes grow, scrotum becomes darker in color
- \_\_\_\_\_ Breasts enlarge, elevating beyond the areolae
