02.21 DIRECTOR'S CRITICAL INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

A. General

These requirements are intended to keep the ISP Director informed of serious incidents from programs and district offices throughout the state. Issues may arise for which the ISP director needs to be made aware prior to the issue being publicized in the media or transmitted through other channels.

B. Requirements

The following incidents require immediate notification to the ISP Director. Affirmative notification will be made through the chain of command up to the Director:

- 1. ISP fleet crashes resulting in the injury or death of anyone;
- 2. on-the-job death or serious injury of an ISP employee;
- 3. any fatalities with which ISP was in any way involved, other than for investigative purposes;
- 4. high-profile fatality or serious injury crash;
- 5. death or serious injury of another at the hands of an ISP trooper;
- 6. ISP trooper deployment of lethal force on a person;
- 7. Critical Incident Task Force (CITF) information regarding the ISP investigation involving the death of an Idaho law enforcement officer;
- 8. serious threat made to an ISP employee or facility;
- 9. arrest of an Idaho law enforcement officer by an ISP trooper;
- 10. arrest of an elected official by an ISP trooper;
- 11. significant damage to an ISP facility or asset;
- 12. a high profile incident likely to result in media interest or coverage; or
- 13. ISP employee charged with felony crime.
