IDAHO STATE POLICE PROCEDURE

08.07 SPECIAL PROJECTS

I. GENERAL

The following are dedicated funding and grant-funded projects supporting Idaho State Police (ISP) efforts. Activities and reporting is in accordance with the project contract and applicable federal requirements or limitations.

II. DRUG TIP HOTLINE CALLS

- A. Drug tip hotline calls are immediately forwarded to the appropriate district Investigations Office by the Idaho Criminal Intelligence Center (Fusion Center).
 - 1. A detective is assigned the tip and investigates the allegations.
- B. Payments are made to informants under the Drug Tip Hotline pursuant to ISP procedure 08.04 Confidential Informants.

III. ORGANIZED CRIME AND DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE (OCDETF)

- A. An ISP OCDETF Coordinator is appointed by the Operations Majors to:
 - 1. act as the point of contact between the federal task force and ISP in requesting an OCDETF investigation and monitoring contracts;
 - 2. coordinate all OCDETF investigations for ISP
 - 3. keep district Captains/designees informed of OCDETF contracts and requirements associated with adopted cases.
- B. Requests to elevate an investigation to an OCDETF case are made as follows:
 - 1. a detective initiates a request by notifying the district Captain/designee;
 - 2. the district Captain/designee completes and submits a written request to the ISP OCDETF Coordinator including the following information:
 - a. a brief narrative of the investigation to date;
 - b. the goal of the investigation;
 - c. anticipated enforcement tactics;
 - d. length of time to complete the investigation;
 - e. number of personnel needed;
 - f. number of agencies involved;
 - g. cost projections;
 - h. federal agency and officer sponsoring the investigation;
 - i. other pertinent information;
 - 3. the ISP OCDTEF Coordinator reviews the request with the Operations Majors for approval. Once approved the district may proceed with the sponsoring federal agency with proposing the case to the U. S. Attorneys for OCDETF consideration.

- C. Once the investigation has been approved by the OCDETF Regional Coordination Group the original contract will be sent to the ISP OCDETF Coordinator for signature by the Director or the Deputy Director.
- D. While ISP detectives are part of the OCDETF contract, they report operationally to the ISP district chain of command.
