


Crimes Against Persons in 2009 Gender Comparison




25.3% of victims of crimes against persons were under 18 years of age.



Attempts and assaults to murder are classified as aggravated assaults and not as murder.



























Although the object of a kidnap may be to obtain money or property, kidnapping is a crime against persons. This offense includes not only kidnapping and abduction, but hostage taking as well. This category is intended to capture information on only the persons actually kidnapped or abducted, not those persons or organizations paying ransoms. Therefore, for each offense of kidnapping, the victims are only the persons taken or detained against their will.


