Thank you for your letter received on July 11, 2016 asking whether Minnesota will allow reciprocity for any of Idaho's Concealed Weapon Licenses (CWL).

Minnesota recognizes the Idaho Enhanced CWL governed by Idaho Code § 18-3302K that has been determined to be similar to Minnesota law. Minnesota does not recognize the Idaho Original CWL and does not require a formal reciprocity agreement to recognize the Idaho Enhanced CWL.
