According to their website, the American Association for Laboratory Accreditation (A2LA) is a nonprofit, non-governmental, public service, membership society. They are the only independent (meaning that they are not governed by another, "parent" organization), non-profit, internationally-recognized accreditation body in the United States that offers a full range of comprehensive laboratory and laboratory-related accreditation services and training. Services are available to any type of organization, be it private or government. All of their accreditation programs are based on internationally-accepted criteria for competence. In addition to the accreditation of laboratories, A2LA offers programs for the accreditation of inspection bodies, proficiency testing providers, reference material producers and product certification bodies. While ISPFS has switched accreditation providers, ISPFS remains accredited under the ISO 17025:2005 standard. ISPFS has been accredited since 1987 and accredited under the ISO 17025 program since 2007. ISPFS is firmly committed to laboratory accreditation and the management and laboratory practices required to meet this stringent standard.
