

Recertification and Reinstatement Requirements  
As of April 15, 2008

In order to meet the recertification requirements established by the IACP you must complete the following during the two-year certification period:

**Recertification Requirements**

1. Complete a minimum of four (4) evaluations, one of which must be supervised by a certified DRE Instructor (this can be a mock evaluation)
2. Complete a minimum of eight (8) hours of DRE/Drug related Training
3. Submit and updated Curriculum Vitae to your regional or agency coordinator.
  - a. The CV needs to be forwarded to the state coordinator to keep on file.
4. Submit a copy of your rolling log to your regional or agency coordinator that corresponds with the certification period.
  - a. This also needs to be forwarded to the state coordinator to keep on file.

**Reinstatement Requirements**

(From deletion from IACP Database to five (5) years.)

1. Retake the one hundred (100) question written test, scoring an 80% or better.
2. Complete a minimum of four (4) evaluations while being supervised by a certified DRE Instructor.
  - a. A toxicological sample MUST be obtained on at least three (3).
  - b. The DREs opinion must be supported by the toxicological sample on each evaluation.
3. Submit updated Curriculum Vitae to your regional or agency coordinator.
  - a. The CV needs to be forwarded to state coordinator to keep in your file.
4. Submit an updated rolling log to your regional or agency coordinator.
  - a. This also needs to be forwarded to state coordinator to keep on file.

**Reinstatement Requirements**

(Greater than Five (5) years)

Retake the entire DRE School again  
Classroom, field certification training and final knowledge exam.
