All general rooms are open to the public until capacity is reached. At that time, proceedings may be available via live stream in designated overflow areas. When seating is limited, check the Legislative Information Desk located on the Garden Level of the central rotunda.

The public is reminded that legislative schedules may change with little or no notice for various reasons. Updated schedules are posted at legislature.idaho.gov/committees.
